- **Cop2Cop Crisis Unit: for Trauma & Critical Incident Response/C2C Crisis Debriefing/Psychological First Aid Team:** C2C Peer Support for Traumatic Incidents, i.e. shootings, suicides, deaths, child involved, accidents-media-Defusing/Debriefing/follow-up
- **Addictions:** Cops battling addictions program peer support, “Bottles & Badges” etc.
